The LJC The Cornerstone of the Program

- LJC = Local Joint Committee
- Spending and programming decisions made locally by union and company officers
- ICD does not make decisions for you; we advise on policy and provide technical assistance
- Typically union officer(s) and at least one company rep
- ICD delivers on-demand training as needed as well as schedule training events every year





Funding

Through negotiations, companies set aside funding for each hour worked by a steelworker. Currently, steel sites set aside \$0.15 per hour and rubber sites \$0.10 per hour.

15 cents per hour

2,080 hours worked x \$0.15 = \$312

10 cents per hour

2,080 hours worked x \$0.10 = \$208
