The following criteria must be met to be eligible for the scholarship drawing:

- Applicant must be a high school graduate enrolled in college and beginning in the fall semester of 2020 or the spring semester of 2021 or a college student returning to school in the fall semester of 2020 or spring semester of 2021.
- Applicant must have maintained, in the past, at least a cumulative 3.0 grade point average and can demonstrate this with a transcript if selected.
- Applicant must be the child/grandchild of a United Steelworkers member who is currently eligible to participate in the Career Development Program.

You can subscribe to **Toolingu** without paying anything out of pocket. The subscription is \$500 for the year. You get access to all of their content. They offer a library of online technical courses in the area of manufacturing technology. Check them out at <https://partners.toolingu.com/icd/> Access is available 24/7.



You can also subscribe to **Rosetta Stone** without paying anything out of pocket. The subscription is \$499 for the year. Rosetta Stone has been an industry leader in providing language education. You get to pick which one of several language you want to learn. Access is 24/7 from your device. To learn more, go to www.RosettaStone.com



LinkedIn Learning used to be Lynda.com. They offer a large library of programs that cover Business, Software, Technology and Creative avenues. You can access your account 24/7. We do not have a voucher system with this program. You would need to fill out a Tuition Assistance Application and pay for the program, providing a receipt. 

In-Person Classes During Covid-19 @ ICD



With a pandemic on our hands, we've had to modify your education benefit for your safety and the safety of our instructors. We have folks at high risk (including your Coordinator) so we will all be safe for them and all of our team members.

STUDENTS:

- * To register for a class, students will sign and date a registration form agreeing to follow new safety protocols while at the ICD.
- * If you are sick, do not come to class. We have wonderful instructors who will try to keep you up to date.
- * When you enter, there's a table. Use **hand sanitizer** first. **Mask** up. Take your **temp**. Gloves are optional and up to the student.
- * When in class, **social distance**. The large training room has tables and chairs moved to allow for 6' social distancing.
- * Masks remain on during the entire class covering your nose and mouth.

Instructors:

- * If they are sick, they will notify the Coordinator and students. Class will be rescheduled.
- * Instructors will follow the same protocols when they enter the building as a student.
- * Instructors will keep any shared items for students cleaned/sanitized between students/classes.
- * Instructors will sanitize their class area after each class.

ICD Coordinator:

- * If the Coordinator is sick, she will not be in-person at the ICD.
- * The Coordinator will follow the same safety protocol when entering the building.
- * The Coordinator will sanitize after each class.
- * The Coordinator will make sure there is sanitizer available at the front desk, the sign-in area and in the training areas.
- * The Coordinator will find alternatives if an in-person class is not deemed safe.
