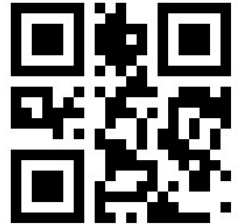

2 WAYS TO UTILIZE YOUR CAREER DEVELOPMENT FUNDS

1: CUSTOMIZED COURSES

COURSE CATALOGS ARE MAILED TO YOUR HOME TWICE A YEAR IN JUNE AND DECEMBER

- Classes are open to active Union Steelworkers.
- Classes will be taken on the employee's own time.
- **If you have to drop, you MUST contact Career Development or you will get charged** the class amount against your yearly limit.

CUSTOMIZED CLASSES LIMITS

The Governing board for ICD has a limit on customized classes of \$2,000 per participant per calendar year. This means in most cases, each participant will be able to take approximately 5 classes per year. **Also, there is a limit of 2 customized courses per year in some personal development courses.** If you have any questions, call your career development office.

2: TUITION ASSISTANCE

USW MEMBERS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR TUITION ASSISTANCE

In addition to customized classes, members are eligible for Tuition Assistance up to a maximum of **\$2,500** a calendar year for accredited schools. Funds may be used for tuition, required textbooks, and course-related fees. Funds cannot be used to pay for materials, equipment or supplies. **The Tuition Assistance Funds are separate from the \$2,000 Customized Class Fund.** (With combined funds, you may use up to a maximum of \$4500 a calendar year (Jan-Dec) for a properly accredited school).

To apply for Tuition Assistance, please contact your Career Development Office.

Tino Fulimeni Scholarship Fund

In 2026, ICD will award five \$1,000 scholarships to various children and grandchildren of steelworkers.

The *Tino Fulimeni Scholarship Fund* was established to honor the memory of Brother Fulimeni. Tino was a fanatic about ICD. His commitment and contribution are evident in the success of the Career Development Program. The *Fund* is administered by ICD in Merrillville, IN.

Criteria to be met for eligibility of scholarship drawing:

- To be eligible, applicants must be a college student starting or returning in the fall of 2026 or spring of 2027, or enrolled in a recognized vocational or training program for the same periods.
- Applicant must have a 3.0 GPA and must provide a transcript if selected.
- Applicant must be the child/grandchild of a steelworker who is currently eligible to participate in the Career Development Program

Application deadline is April 15, 2026.
