Heating and air conditioning equipment is rapidly changing due to new regulations on refrigerants and energy efficiency standards. New refrigerants have come into the market and HVAC technology is continuing to advance. This class will instruct the learner on working with all 4 residential Air Conditioning Refrigerants: R-22, R-410a, R-32, and R-454b. In addition, students will learn about new motor technology, airflow calculations, advanced troubleshooting, brazing and other pipe joining techniques, and sheet metal transitions. **Prerequisites: Take Residential Heating and Cooling Certification and Training through ICD OR be EPA 608 certified.**

The second phase of this hands-on course includes the installation of steel pipe from breaker to box to device, junction and ceiling mounted boxes. The following will be addressed for new construction projects: the wiring of circuit breakers, switches, lighting, and receptacle outlets.

Repair shops charge ninety-five to one hundred twenty dollars an hour for tuning up, repairing or prepping equipment for storage. Bring equipment into class for hands-on training.

Participants will learn how common pin-tumbler locks function and how various lock-picking tools interact with internal components. Students will work directly with transparent acrylic training locks, allowing them to visually observe the internal movement of the pins while practicing techniques such as tension control, single-pin picking and raking. Each student will receive a Long Shackle Solid Brass Padlock set to take home.
