Site Coordinator's Role

- 1. Coordinate book purchase with the instructor or with the JobLink coordinator.
- 2. Enroll students in the database.
- 3. Introduce students to how L & O classes works and how to access the videos and handouts.
- 4. Contact the webmaster/instructor in a timely fashion if any problems arise.

Paying for an L & O Class

Each instructor will send site coordinators an invoice for the class. Please note that the *streaming only* classes are charged at half course price. So a \$400 per person charge will only be \$200 for those students who are only participating through streaming.

In addition, site coordinators will receive an invoice for the tech fee for all L&O students from our webmaster, Bill Needles. The tech fee is based on the number of weeks a class runs; the cost ranges between \$15 to \$45 per enrolled student.

Webmaster's Obligation
